

Your child is enrolled in the Photography course at St. Thomas More this semester. As part of the St. Thomas More Technology program, students will be allowed to move freely in and around the building at St. Thomas More during class time in order to shoot still images for projects or assignments. This means that, during these times, students may no longer be under the direct supervision of their teacher. Students will be given specific direction on locations that they may produce their media recorded events. Students will be provided with guidelines to ensure they exercise proper behavior during these times. Students are also informed that at no point during class time are they permitted to leave school property. Leaving the classroom is an important part of the Photography program, as it allows student's to use the fundamental skills that they have learned in class and apply them within a greater environment. Separate permission request forms will always be sent where any activity will happen off school property; such as field trips, excursions, or retreats.

The safety of the class depends, in part, upon the responsibility and integrity of every student. Students taking the Photography course must also be required to review the classroom policies with their parent/guardian. Breaking school rules or safety protocols during class time may result in increased risk of personal harm to the student, others, or school equipment. Breaking these rules and protocols will result in immediate disciplinary action and/or further consequences. For serious infractions, students may be sent to the office to meet with a Vice Principal for further action. Such infractions are treated seriously; because the risks and consequences can be serious, not only for the individual(s), but also for the group as a whole.

If you are concerned about any aspect of this specific policy or other classroom policies, as outlined in the Code of Conduct, please do not hesitate to contact me so that we can try to resolve concerns and enable all our students to participate as fully as possible.
